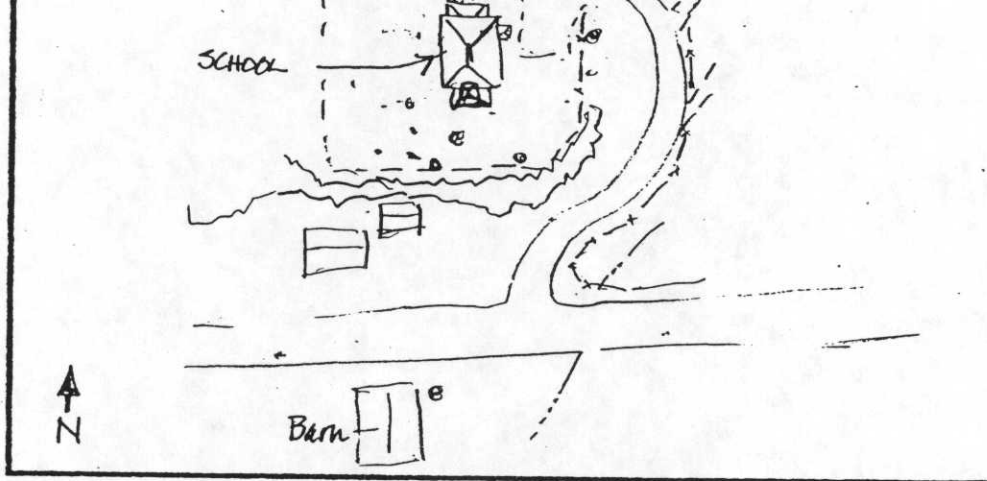

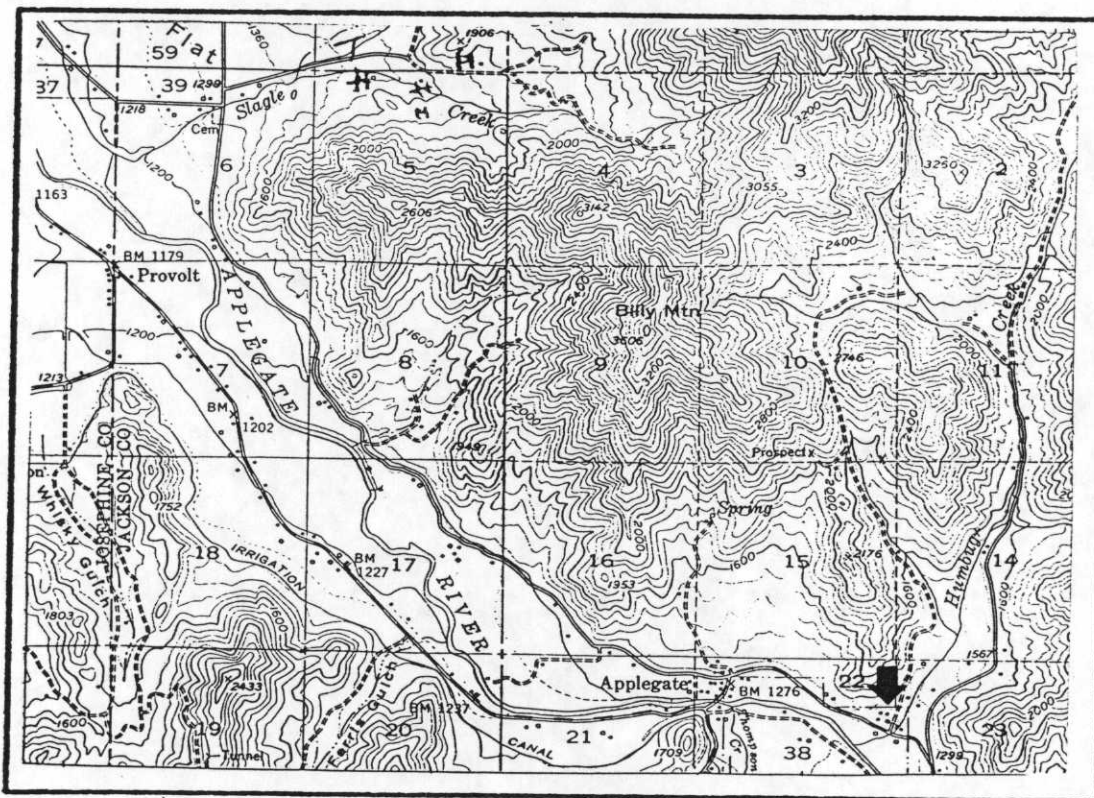

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Applegate School is a one and one-half story, brick and concrete structure located on a knoll, above and to the north of the Medford-Provolt Highway #238, one-half mile east of Applegate, Oregon. The building has a hipped roof, one-over-one, double hung sash windows with arched lintels and an open belfry toward the front (south) elevation. The belfry, projecting porch and a once existing curved and stylized parapet cornice wall, all originally covered in shingle work, resembled the design used at the Table Rock and Willow Springs Schools (see file sheets).

The Applegate School District #40, was organized under the name of Bridge Point on February 17, 1876. After 1882, it was referred to by its present name. This school was featured in a 1912, promotional publication by the Medford Commercial Club, showing the quality of the educational facilities in rural Jackson County. The building has served the educational and community needs of Applegate, Oregon since its construction.
